

ANJC 2023 Elections Procedures & Timeline

- **June 12:** HQ announces to members that ANJC is accepting nominations for elections.
- **June 12:** Petitions are available through ANJC HQ for eligibility to become candidate for upcoming 2023 elections.
- **June 26:** The date which member's dues must be current in order to be eligible to vote (must have been a member since January 1, 2023).
- **July 3:** ANJC members are eligible to run for an office if they are in *good standing* as of July 3, 2023.
- **July 10:** Candidates for ANJC State Board, Alternates and ANJC Regional Boards shall be selected by search committee appointed by the Regional Chair of each Region. Nominees shall be approved by a simple majority vote of that regional board from each region and submitted to ANJC HQ.
- **August 1:** ANJC members cannot change their voting districts after August 1st. Following elections, that restriction will be lifted.
- **August 2:** Nomination by petition for all positions must be submitted to and received by ANJC HQ by return receipt mail postmarked no later than August 3rd and received no later than August 7, 2023.
- August 11: If no petitions or search committee nominations are received for any
 positions by August 7, 2023, the regional chair will appoint, with regional board approval,
 a member in good standing to fill any State Board or Regional Board vacancy and must
 supply executive director names of candidates for election by August 13.
- August 13: Campaign period runs from August 13- September 16, 2023.
- **September 17 October 6:** Election runs during this period and ends 5pm, October 6, 2023.
- **October 11:** Election certified by executive director and winners announced no later than October 11th.
- **December 7:** ANJC State Board meeting held December 7, 2023 would be first meeting to include all new elected officials.

Ballots to be mailed to qualified ANJC members

- **September 17:** Ballots e-mailed to members in good standing.
- October 6: Date all ballots must be received electronically to be considered valid.
- October 7: Ballots retrieved, tabulated and verified from electronic balloting company.
- October 1: All contested ballots will be decided by ED and certified.



Run-Off

If there is a tie, procedures similar to those outlined above will be in place with run-off elections concluded no later than **November 17**, **2023**.

Ballots for Run-Off

- Voting runs October 28 November 5, 2023.
- Electronic ballots will be e-mailed by **October 28, 2023** and must be received by Electronic Balloting Company no later than **November 5, 2023**.
- Winners announced **November 9, 2023**.
